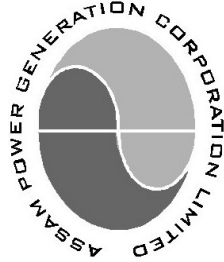

OBJECTIVE:

Lakwa Thermal Power Station (LTPS) is a gas based Power Station consisting of three power houses (Ph-I, Ph-II & Ph-III) with total installed capacity of 157.2 MW. All the Gas and Steam Turbines are running in synchronization with the National Grid. The power evacuation from LTPS to the grid is done through various 132 KV Feeders.

In order to evade any untoward fire hazard in the individual units, power houses and switchyards, Fire Fighting Systems comprising of CO₂, DCP and Mechanical Foam are in use. In due course of time, few of these fire fighting cylinders have become either fully or partially empty or their fire fighting materials have expired. Hence, to keep the system in operation and considering the safety of the Plant, it is intended to refill these empty cylinders as per statutory norms. In addition, it is also intended to replace a few damaged fittings of the existing Fire Fighting Cylinders for their safe and proper operation.

(A) GENERAL

The General Manager, LTPS, APGCL invites two bids sealed tender from reputed manufacturer/firms for the work of:

“Refilling, Servicing, Commissioning & Testing of the existing Fire Fighting cylinders including Supply of Chemicals, Accessories etc.”

The tender documents (non-transferable) can only be obtained from the office of the General Manager, LTPS, APGCL, Maibella. Payment shall be made by Demand Draft drawn in favor of **Asstt. Manager (Accts.), LTPS, APGCL, Maibella payable at SBI, LTTP branch, IFS Code SBIN006011.** The Tender document may also be downloaded from the APGCL's website (www.apgcl.org) in which case the Tender fee has to be submitted along with the Technical Bid in the shape of Demand Draft duly pledged in favour of **Asstt. Manager (Accts.), LTPS, APGCL, Maibella.**

(B) INTENT OF SPECIFICATION:

This tender specification is intended to furnish the scope of work, material specification as well as to inform other technical and commercial requirements to be furnished by the bidders along with their bid documents.

(C) ELIGIBILITY OF BIDDER:

- (i) The bidder must be a **manufacturer or manufacturer's authorized Firm** of fire extinguisher. Documentary evidence in this regard is to be submitted along with technical part of the Bid. In case the bidder is not a manufacturer of fire extinguishers, necessary authorization from the manufacturer to the bidder must be furnished along with the technical part of the bid, in the absence of which the submitted bid may not be accepted at this end.
- (ii) The bidder must have the experience of carrying out similar at least 02 works of refilling fire fighting cylinders during the last 3 (three) financial years. Documentary evidence (for instance work order/work completion certificate copies, at least one) must be furnished along with the technical part of the Bid in the absence of which their experience shall not be considered. Further, the intending bidder must fulfill all the requisite clauses of tender.
- (iii) **Financial capability:** The bidder must have financial capability of carrying out the work. The bidder must furnish documentary evidence (for the instance of work completion certificate) for undertaking similar work amounting to not less than Rs 2.0 lakhs during the last 03 (three) financial years. Bidder is to furnish last financial year's balance sheet and Profit & Loss Statement in support of their financial capability.

(D) Scope of Work:

- i) **Refilling, Servicing, Commissioning & Testing of the existing Fire Fighting cylinders including Supply of Chemicals, Accessories etc.**

- ii) **Testing and demonstration of refilled fire fighting cylinders are to be done as per clause no. 24 of this tender.**

Note: The offered price of bidder must include charges for supply of fire fighting chemicals and accessories and refilling, servicing & testing of the existing fire-fighting cylinders only. **Bidders are specifically requested to visit LTPS site (on working days only) for assessment of accessories that will be required for complete commissioning of the fire fighting cylinders. During**

execution of the work, any additional accessories, if required, for successful completion of the work shall entirely be at bidder's scope. Any other expenses that may be incurred during execution of the above work shall be at bidder's scope and APGCL will not take cognizance of such addition expense.

E) GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO THE BIDDER:

1) One set of Biding document (Tender document) will be issued to intending bidder on submission of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) in the shape of Demand Draft duly pledged in favour of the **Asstt. Manager (Accts.), LTPS, APGCL, Maibella**. The Tender document may also be downloaded from the APGCL's website (www.apgcl.org) in which case the Tender fee has to be submitted along with the Technical Bid in the shape of Demand Draft duly pledged in favour of the **Asstt. Manager (Accts.), LTPS, APGCL, Maibella**. **Bidder shall submit tender document duly signed and stamped on each page of tender in token of his acceptance along with his bid.**

2) The bid shall be completed in two bid system as directed below:

Technical & un-priced commercial part – Technical bid.
Priced commercial part – Price bid.

3) Page number in the bottom of the entire bid document is mandatory.

4) Technical and Un-priced Part – Technical Bid:

This part shall contain technical and commercial (Un-priced) bid and shall have to contain the following as mentioned below:

This envelop shall comprise the signed copy of bidding document (Tender document), Addendum (if any). **Techno-commercial bid disclosing price shall be summarily rejected.**

 - (iii) In case a company (whether private or public), attested copy of 'Certificate of Incorporation' together with attested Memorandum / Articles of Association.
- e) Any other relevant document, bidder desires to submit.

5) **Priced Commercial Part – Price Bid:**

Priced commercial part shall contain "Offered Price" dully filled in two copies i.e. one ORIGINAL COPY and one DUPLICATE COPY, shall be submitted. Priced part shall be **inclusive of all taxes and duties except service tax** which must be shown separately in the price bid. No stipulation, deviation, terms and conditions, presumption, etc shall be stipulated in Priced part of bid. APGCL shall not take cognizance of any such statement and may at their discretion reject such price bids.

6) **Submission of Bid:**

Technical & Un-priced and Priced part must be submitted in two separate **sealed** envelopes. The two sealed envelopes of both un-priced and priced parts shall have to be put to an outer cover which is also to be sealed. The outer cover should duly bear the Tender Number, date and time of opening of the bid along with address of the office.

The envelope shall have following information clearly written on the outside of the envelope, failing which APGCL will assume no responsibility for the misplacement or premature opening of the bid.

Important Note:

- a. **The offered price shall include rates of firefighting chemicals along with CO₂ gas cartridge (wherever required), fittings/accessories and servicing, refilling and commissioning of fire-fighting cylinders in complete.**
- b. **The price evaluation shall be done on the total of the entire work as stipulated in the clause "Scope of Work" of this tender.**
- c. **No part offer shall be accepted at this end and bidder must quote for the entire scope of work in full.**

The following information shall have to be clearly written on outside of the envelope, failing which APGCL will assume no responsibility for the misplacement or premature opening of the bid.

- ii) Bid received after the time and date fixed for receipt of bid is liable for rejection.

8) BID Opening:

a) Opening of Techno-commercial & Un-priced Part of Bid:

- i) On the date and time mentioned in 'Notice Inviting Tender', the Technical and Un-priced Commercial Part will be opened in the office of the General Manager, LTPS, APGCL, Maibella, P.O.-Suffry, Dist. Sivasagar, Assam, Pin-785 689.
- ii) In the event the specified date of bid opening is declared a holiday for APGCL, the bid shall be opened on the next working day at the specified time and location.
- iii) Clarification and Additional Information: During bid evaluation, APGCL may request bidder for any clarification on the bid, additional or outstanding documents. Bidder shall submit all additional documents in one original and one duplicate copy. However, seeking clarification shall be on sole discretion of APGCL.
- iv) Bid of the bidder who submits the required EMD shall be taken up for detailed evaluation.
- v) During pre bid discussion, Techno-commercial discretions with bidder shall be arranged. If needed, bidder shall depute authorized representative(s) for attending the discussion. The representative(s) attending the discussions shall produce authorization from the organization to attend the discussions and sign the minutes on behalf of the organization. The authorized representative(s) must be competent and empowered to settle all technical and commercial issues.

b) Opening of Priced part of the Bid:

Price Commercial Part will be opened of only those bidders whose bids are considered Techno-commercially acceptable.

9) BID Evaluation Criteria:

a) Techno-commercial Part:

- i) The Techno-commercial Part of bid shall be evaluated as per bid evaluation criteria. The bid must be accompanied with EMD as specified in the tender.
- ii) Deviation to critical stipulation: Deviations to critical stipulations of bidding document as mentioned below are not acceptable. Bidder taking deviations to the following bid stipulations may not be considered for price bid opening.
 - a. EMD
 - b. Firm Price
 - c. Performance Bank Guarantee
 - d. Payment terms
 - e. Liquidated Damage.
 - f. Copies of PAN card, valid Service Tax registration certificate and valid sales taxes registration certificate, GRN/WC-II.
 - g. Experience/Eligibility of Bidder.
- iii) Bidders must ensure that complete bid along with all details as sought are submitted as per provisions of the bidding document.
- iv) The Techno-commercial Part of bid shall be evaluated as per clauses stipulated in this tender document and as per instructions laid down in the document "General Instruction for Supply and Erection of APGCL". If any

clauses of this tender contradicts with that in the document "General Instruction for Supply and Erection of APGCL", those in the tender document shall prevail.

- b) Price Part:
 The 'Offered Price' and its break up quoted by the bidder shall be taken up for evaluation on overall basis. Price bids containing additional qualifications not mentioned in Techno-commercial Part of the bid shall be summarily rejected.

10) Owner's right to accept or reject a Bid:

APGCL reserves the right to accept a bid other than the lowest and to accept or reject any bid in whole or part, or to reject all bids with or without notice or reasons. Such decisions by APGCL shall bear no liability whatsoever consequence upon such decisions.

11) Award of Supply:

- a) The bidder whose bid is accepted by APGCL shall be issued Confirmed Order/Letter of Intent prior to expiry of bid validity. Bidder shall confirm acceptance by returning a signed copy of the Order within **10 (Ten) days** from the date of issue of Confirmed order.
 b) APGCL shall not be obliged to furnish any information / clarification / explanation to the unsuccessful bidders as regards of non-acceptance of their bids. Except for refund of EMD (without interest) to unsuccessful bidder, APGCL shall correspond only with the successful bidder.

NOTE: Bidders are advised not to stipulate any deviation(s) / condition(s) and to confirm compliance to tender conditions in Toto. 13) Location:

The location of work shall be Phase-I, II & III Power Houses & switchyards of LTPS, APGCL, Maibella.

14) Guarantee:

The entire work as state under clause no. D, "Scope of Work" shall be guaranteed against any failure/defect for a period of 12 months from the date of commissioning. Free replacement of these materials shall have to be made for any defect that may develop under normal use during this guarantee period. The free replacement should be made within a reasonable time period as determined and directed by the undersigned.

15) Completion Period:

The entire scope of work, as detailed in Clause-D of this tender must be completed within **sixty (60) days** from the date of issue of formal work order. Liquidated damage due to delay in execution of the contract in full shall be levied as per the Liquidated Damage Clause (Clause no. E 26) of the tender.

16) **Terms of Payment:**

- a) 100% payment inclusive of all taxes and duties shall be made after successful completion of the work (as per clause D) to full satisfaction of APGCL and subjected to fulfillment of Performance Bank Guarantee Clause (Clause no. E-19) of the tender.
- b) The bidder shall submit the bill in triplicate for payment.

17) **Earnest Money Deposit:**

EMD (lump sum) of Rs. 7,000/- (Rupees seven Thousand Only) in the shape of Demand Draft in original of any Nationalized Bank shall be submitted as Earnest Money, duly pledged in favour of the **Asstt. Manager (Accts.)**, LTPS, APGCL, Maibella. APGCL will refund the Earnest Money of the unsuccessful bidders directly to the bidders within a reasonable period of time without any interest.

18) **Security Deposit:**

On receipt of the formal work Order, the successful bidder shall deposit to the extent of 2½% of the total order value as Security Deposit in the shape of Demand Draft of any Nationalized Bank drawn in favour of the **Asstt. Manager (Accts.)**, LTPS, APGCL, Maibella within 7 days time. The Security Deposit shall be released on successful completion of the work covered under the work order. No interest shall be paid against the Security Deposit. In case the bidder does not submit the security deposit within **15 days**, it shall be presumed that the Bidder is not interested to or cannot execute the Order. In such case, APGCL has the right to cancel the Order and award it to the next lowest Bidder.

19) **Performance Bank Guarantee:**

The successful bidder shall have to deposit a bank guarantee from a Nationalized/Scheduled Bank of RBI for an amount equivalent to 10% of the total value of the Order as Performance Security, immediately on acceptance of letter of intent/detailed order, duly pledged in favour of the *Asstt. Manager (Accts.)*, LTPS, APGCL, Maibella and such security deposit shall be valid upto 30 days beyond the Guarantee period. **Our banker is SBI, Lakwa TPP Branch. IFSC: SBIN0006011**

21) **Work Execution Standard:**

The work shall be carried out as per **relevant IS** and original manufacturers recommendations

22) **Test Certificate:**

Manufacturer's Test Certificate of the supplied chemicals & accessories must be submitted during delivery. The certificate of **BIS** of the materials must be submitted.

23) **Manufacturing/Expiry Date:**

The supplied package must bear clearly the date of manufacturing, expiry and the **BIS stamp** of the chemicals without which the materials will not be accepted at this end.

24) Testing & Demonstration:

- a. **Hydrostatic Tests of CO₂ cylinders** that will be refilled are to be performed before refilling as per statutory norms. The Hydrostatic Test certificate to be provided by the vendor from the approved certifier. The hydrostatic test shall be chargeable basis and must be stated in price bid. The charges for the above Hydrostatic test of CO₂ Cylinders shall also include any transportation charge for carrying the cylinders from LTPS site to bidder's premise. **Note:** Any damage occurring during the above hydrostatic test of cylinders and related accessories due to the bidder's fault shall be replaced by the bidder in full.
- b. After refilling of all the cylinders (**i.e., DCP, Mechanical Foam & CO₂ Cylinders**), **Performance Tests** of each type of cylinders are to be performed upto the satisfaction of designated testing committee.
- c. The **above demonstration** of cylinders (as stated under Clause 24-b) shall have to be done by the bidder at site and no additional amount shall be borne by APGCL for the same. The testing committee will select cylinders on random basis for demonstration. In case, the cylinder fails in its **Performance Tests**, similar type another two cylinders will be randomly selected by the test committee. If both the cylinders' test performance is found satisfactory, then only the consignment will be accepted.
In case even one cylinder of the two fails to clear the performance test, then APGCL has the full right to reject the entire chemical of that type and the accessories (if supplied by the contractor) installed with those cylinders. In such case the contractor is to replace the entire rejected consignment.

25) Cylinder Marking:

After successful completion of refilling work, contractor must affix the level on each cylinder showing details of Dates of refilling & expiry of the chemical.

26) Liquidated Damage:

In case of delay in work completion beyond the work completion period as mentioned in clause '15', a penalty @1% (one percent) of the total order value (including all taxes and duties) per week delay subjected to maximum of 10% (ten percent) of the total value will be imposed upon the Contractor. However, the payment of liquidated damage shall not in any way relieve the Contractor from any of its obligation to complete the work or from any other obligation and liabilities of the Contractor under the Contract.

27) Validity of the Offer:

The Offer shall be valid for a period of 120 (one hundred twenty days) from the date of opening of the technical bid.

28) Termination of Contract:

Notwithstanding anything contained elsewhere, APGCL may at any time at its option terminate the contract or part of it after giving 15 days notice in writing to the contractor without assigning any reason and upon such termination APGCL shall have right to remove contractor's material from site and the contractor shall only be paid for the work satisfactorily completed in accordance with the provision of the contract.

If APGCL considers that the performance of the contractor is unsatisfactory or not up to the expected standard, APGCL shall notify the contractor in writing and specify in details the cause of dissatisfaction. APGCL shall have the option to terminate this contract if the contractor fails to comply with the requisitions, contained in the said written notice issued by APGCL.

29) Adherence to Safety Regulations:

Contractor shall ensure that all safety precautions required are observed at all times during the execution of the job as per Govt. statutory norms.

30) **Arbitration Clause:**

All disputes or differences whatever so arising between the parties out of or relating to this Order shall be settled by arbitration as per clause 33.00 of "General Conditions for Supply and Erection of APGCL". The venue of arbitration shall be at Guwahati.

31) **Jurisdiction:**

Subject to arbitration clause, all questions, disputes of differences arising under out of or in connection with the contract shall be subject the exclusive jurisdiction of Courts of Guwahati.

The undersigned reserves the right to accept or reject any or all of the bids without assigning any reason thereof. He is not bound to accept the lowest rate also.

SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Only authorized staff of Contractor having proper Photo Identity Card issued by the Contractor and with Permission granted by Security Depart., LTPS, shall be permitted to execute the refilling and other related works at LTPS. The contractor will have to submit the list of the Authorized Staff along with a set of the Photo Identity Cards to whom permission will be required to be issued by Security Depart., LTPS.
2. The Contractor shall be responsible to fulfill all statutory liabilities, if any towards his staff such as payment of minimum wages, PF, ESI and any other dues etc including all amendments issued by the Govt. from time to time. Being a Principal Employer, LTPS may ask to submit documents in original.
3. No T&Ps shall be issued to the contractor. All T&Ps, Instruments, Machines, etc. will be brought by the Contractor only. The cost of all these items shall be borne by the contractor.
4. Labour: No labour shall be provided by LTPS.
5. Transport: No separate charges will be paid for transport.
6. The manpower cannot be deployed during OFF days/ holidays / night hours.
7. The work is to be carried out as per the recommendation of manufacturers and only original spares /materials consumables **conforming to BIS** shall be used.
8. Works will be monitored by the authorized persons as deputed by LTPS.
9. Testing of the cylinders is to be performed up to the full satisfaction of the authorized person of LTPS.
10. Cleaning of Work place that may be used by work representatives is under the scope of contractor so as to make it free of pollution after completion of work.
11. Advance Payment: No advance of any type shall be paid.
12. Price variation clause: The prices shall be firm without any variation in any way till completion of the work at LTPS site.
13. Statutory charges which will not be borne by the bidder must specifically be mentioned by the bidder, failing which the bidder shall bear the same and APGCL will not be liable for payment of such charges.
14. Any increase in Excise Duty, Sales Tax/CST& Service Tax during the period until completion of the work shall be extra as applicable at the time of delivery.
