Assam Power Generation Corporation Limited is engaged in the development, operation and sale of power in the state of Assam. Presently, APGCL proposes to set up solar PV project on Lump-sum Turn-key (LSTK) basis through qualified selected bidder.

APGCL intends to select and appoint suitable contractor with adequate credentials, through competitive bidding in two-bid system (i.e. PART I: Techno-Commercial Bid and PART II: Price Bid) from eligible bidders for the brief Scope of Work mentioned hereinafter.

Brief Scope of work

Part A - Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC): Design, Engineering, Manufacturing, Supply, Packing and Forwarding, Transportation, Unloading, Storage, Installation, testing and Commissioning of grid connected of 2.0MW AC (with minimum of 2.2 MWp DC) Solar Photo Voltaic Project and comprehensive operation & maintenance of the plant for a period of Five year from the date of successful acceptance of the project.

Part B - Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC): Design, Engineering, Manufacturing, Supply, Packing and Forwarding, Transportation, ROW, Unloading, Storage, Installation, testing and commissioning of transmission line from plant switch yard to Namrup Gas turbine power station switchyard for approximately 1.5 km.

Company should not be loss-making in the last 3 financial years.

The Tenderer shall furnish all necessary documents for the bidding entity in support of each qualification criteria and experience along with their offer.

Any bidder who has downloaded the tender document from APGCL website shall not construe the same as his qualification for the tendered work.

Bidder shall download the Bidding Document in his own name and submit the bid directly.

The Bidding Document is non-transferable.

APGCL shall not be responsible for any expense incurred by bidders in connection with the preparation & delivery of their bids, site visit and other expenses incurred during bidding process

APGCL reserves the right to assess bidder's capability and capacity to execute the work using in-house information and by taking into account other aspects such as concurrent commitments and past performance.

Bidder submitting his bid should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings.

Fax/ E-mail / Hard Copy of bids shall not be accepted.

APGCL reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel/ withdraw the Invitation for Bids without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no bidder / intending bidder shall have any claim arising out of such action.

If the last date of receiving/ opening of the tenders coincide with a holiday, then the next working day shall be the receiving/ opening date.

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, APGCL may for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a bidder, modify the NIT by amendment/corrigendum.

The amendment/corrigendum, if any, will be notified through e-Tender portal to all bidders who have downloaded the Tender Document and will be binding on them.

In order to offer bidders reasonable time in which to take the amendment/corrigendum in consideration in preparing their bids, APGCL may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of bids.

In exceptional circumstances, APGCL may solicit the bidder's consent to an extension of the period of validity of bid. The request and the response there to shall be made by Fax / e- mail/ e-Tender portal. The bidder, extending the validity of the bid, will not be permitted to modify the bid.

After opening of bids, to assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of bids, APGCL may, at its discretion, ask the bidder for a clarification on its bid. The request for such clarification and the response shall be in writing through e-Tender portal only.
