

**Information to the candidates appearing for CBT mode Examination of AM, JM, AAO  
in APGCL vide Employment Notice No. HR/APGCL/Esstt/2020/1195/07 dated  
01/12/2020**

**A) Steps to download Question Paper & Answer Keys**

1. Visit the official website of APGCL ([www.apgcl.org](http://www.apgcl.org)).
2. Login with Application Number and password
3. Navigate to the link –'Question Paper'to display Question Paper
4. Navigate to the link – 'Answer key' to display Answer Key

**How to raise Objection for Answer Key**

Candidates who are not satisfied with answer key will be allowed to challenge the same within a given time period.

A processing fee of Rs.300 per Objection must be paid to the authority.

**Candidates must note that the processing fee will not be refunded to the candidate's account even if the challenge is correct.**

**No challenge will be accepted without receipt of the processing fee.**

**Steps to challenge "answer key" are given below:**

- Visit the official website of APGCL ([www.apgcl.org](http://www.apgcl.org)).
- Login with Application Number and password
- Click on the 'Objection(s) regarding Answer Key' link.
- If any candidates want to raise objection for question, they may select Question ID by clicking the Dropdown.
- The Question of selected ID will appear on the display
- Candidate may select objection from following option
  - Question is wrong
  - Incorrect Option
  - Multiple Options are correct
  - None of the option is correct
  - Any Other
- Candidate may enter remark in Text Field.
  
- Candidates have to upload the necessary supporting documents in the form of PDF by clicking on the 'Upload Reference Document' button on the screen
- Click on 'Submit' button submit objection.
- Submitted objection will display in footer.
- Candidate can raise multiple objections.
- For Payment Click on 'Make Online Payment for Complain'.
- Select No. of Objection from submitted Objections, according to selection fee will be calculated.
- Pay the processing fee through debit/credit/net banking

**B) Criteria to determine in case of Tie-up in total marks for CBT examination of APGCL**

In case of a Tie in score the following methods will be followed:

In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in their examination, the inter-se-merit of such candidates will be determined in the order of preference as under: -

- i) Total Marks Scored in Core Subject (Part -B)
- ii) Total Marks Scored in (Part –A)
- iii) Less Negative Marks scored in Part B will be preferred. If the tie still persists, then an older candidate will be preferred over a younger candidate.
